## The ESAVS Certificate

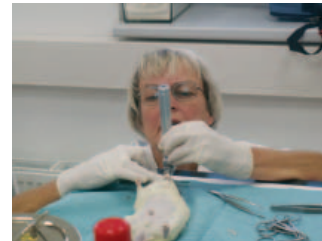
The ESAVS Certificate of Small Animal Veterinary Practice is granted by the ESAVS of the University of Luxembourg, complying with the rules and regulations laid down by the Ministry of Higher Education of the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg.

The ESAVS Certificate of Small Animal Veterinary Practice (ECSAVP) involves coursework within the existing framework of ESAVS courses and work carried out in the veterinary practices of the participating students.

CPD (Continuing Professional Development) credit points are acquired over a period of three to five years for successful participation. All work done in the program is validated by examinations.

The ECSAVP testifies that a veterinarian has acquired an advanced level of competence in small animal practice. It is not a specialist diploma, nor is it a licence for a particular type of professional activity. It is intended that this certificate will support the growing demand for national and possible future international systems for species specific practice certification. It will also provide a benchmark for veterinarians who wish to increase their knowledge and develop a habit of lifelong learning.

### Note:

All courses and correspondence are in ENGLISH and depending on the course range from between 5 and 12 days in length.

### Focus:

Continuing Education in Veterinary Medicine

### 1. Discipline Oriented Study Programs

ESAVS discipline oriented programs, based on the concept of "Advanced Veterinary Studies"

#### 1.1. Standard study programs:

- Residential Courses: 2-3 (1 per year)
- Distance learning modules: 1-2
- Requirements: university education and academic degree

#### 1.2. Intensive courses:

- Residential course: 1
- Distance learning module: 0
- Requirements: university education, academic degree and advanced experience.

### 2. Case Oriented Study Programs

ESAVS case oriented study programs, based on the conception of "Excellence in Veterinary Therapy"

#### 2.1 Standard study programs:

- Residential courses: 8 (at about half year intervals)
- Distance learning modules: 0
- Requirements: university education and academic degree
- Focus: the full program will cover all organ systems and will also provide information on practice management. Each course may be booked independently from each other.
- Location: the program is organised in a similar way in Europe and Asia.
